LOST WEAVES OF MAHARASHTRA

Is Paithani the only popular textile of Maharashtra? Is everything woven in Paithan entitled to be addressed as Paithani? What are the other textile traditions that were known to Maharashtra?

There is not much documentation available for some of the weaves. Today, **Vinay Narkar** will be presenting us with some of the answers to these questions and most importantly how folk literature has helped him in reviving 2 textile traditions of Mahatrashtra namely Chandrakala and Joat.

Vinay Narkar is a weaver whose fascination lies in reviving the forgotten weaves of Maharashtra. He has written articles about the decaying Indian weaves and Textile Traditions of Maharashtra 2020 and 2021 in the leading Marathi newspaper, Loksatta. He has revived textiles like Irkal, Chandrakala sarees, Cotton Paithanis, Joat sarees of Vidarbha and Paithani Shalu sarees of Maharashtra.

In this session, **Dipali Khandelwal**, communications consultant at Jaipur Rugs, will discuss building the best artisan proposition for the Global Hand Knotted carpet industry, by connecting artisans and customers directly to each other and nurturing co-creation.

Jaipur Rugs is a for-profit social enterprise that combines the pursuit of profit with the spreading of kindness, with the aim of benefiting all the people sitting around its rugs; customers, artisans, local communities, employees, suppliers, buyers and partners.

Founded in 1978 by NK Chaudhary, Jaipur Rugs revolutionized the carpet industry by creating an entirely new business model – working directly with artisans and empowering them and their communities with a sustainable livelihood.

Dipali will share the 3-phase Jaipur Rugs model that is enabling and empowering thousands of people across the globe. She will talk about the importance of frontline in a craft-based business, building selfmanagement for deeper impact, and connecting rural artisans to international markets.

Today we welcome **Vedika Kochhar, Art conservator, restorer and consultant.** She is the founder of **Partum Restauro,** a conservation Studio in Mumbai.
